ROYAL VICTORIA PLACE – CAR PARK CLOSURE

RVP car park is temporarily closed between 2 June and 14 July 2025 while concrete repairs, redecoration and waterproofing works are undertaken to the entrance and exit levels.

Parking will be available in nearby Meadow Road and Crescent Road car parks and season tickets will be valid in these car parks while the RVP car park total closure is taking place.

The car park works will continue until summer 2026. Although the car park reopens on 14 July, sections will be periodically closed for practical and health and safety reasons to facilitate the ongoing works. The contractor, Baxalls, will continue to provide updates throughout the works programme.

SPEEDWATCH - CAN YOU HELP?

Speedwatch is a community-based scheme where volunteers record the speed of passing vehicles in the area where they live. Around 90% of vehicles observed once by Speedwatch volunteers are not seen speeding again in the next 12 months.

We already have an active Speedwatch group in Horsmonden, who do a great job, but they are desperately in need of more volunteers.
